

May 2008 Membership Meeting Minutes  
ASIS Chapter 059

The May meeting of Chapter 059 was held at the Olive Garden Restaurant, 7505 Dodge St., Omaha, NE. Chair Jim Bogner opened the meeting at 11:40 am with the Pledge of Allegiance. There were 30 attendees, who each introduced themselves.

Chair Jim Bogner announced that Chapter 059 brought in 48 new members last year and was awarded a free attendee registration for the national seminar in Atlanta in September. Law Enforcement Appreciation Luncheon Committee Member Joe Davitt provided members with an update on the planning for this year's luncheon on October 15<sup>th</sup>. Joe announced that Tom Osborne will be the keynote speaker.

Treasurer Brian Michalski updated the membership on the chapter's recent Community Service Project, which was a security survey of Columbus Community College, Columbus, NE on May 6<sup>th</sup>, 2008.

Jim Bogner announced that the chapter has started a CPP study group this past month. Orders were taken for ASIS Study Guides.
